

# RESOURCES CHECKLIST FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF THE INTER-NDA

## PERSONNEL

Capacity to recruit non-specialist field workers (minimum educational level: primary; no prior experience with neuropsychology/healthcare necessary; preferably local women/mothers) to implement assessments. Assessors must be fluent in the local language.

## FORMS & KITS

Capacity for translation, back translation & cultural customisation of INTER-NDA forms.  
Assembly of kit consisting of simple household items encountered globally. Items may be sourced locally.

## TRAINING

Ability to organise a room with internet access for a one-day E-training program or a 2-3 day in-person training program.

## STANDARDIZATION

Assessors to complete standardisation & reliability exercises with trainer. This can be done virtually.

## PILOTING

Capacity to pilot the test in your setting in 30-50 children. Issues identified are discussed with INTER-NDA team and troubleshooting strategy agreed.

## MONITORING+ REFERRAL

Capacity for data storage for monitoring purposes and to trigger local referral pathways, including transfer of INTER-NDA score chart to clinician

## PERFORMANCE MONITORING

Re-standarization of assessors every 2-3 years as required.

## OVERVIEW OF DIRECT COSTS
